

SHOW WEEK SCHEDULE - DECEMBER 8 - 14



ALL REHEARSALS WILL BE HELD AT THE UWG TOWNSEND CENTER. NO CLASSES OR REHEARSALS WILL BE HELD IN STUDIO DECEMBER 8-14.

- The show week schedule for December 8-12 includes all stage rehearsals for Nutcracker and Winter Extravaganza, Nutcracker photography days, Nutcracker dress rehearsal, and a breakdown of both show days.
- IF a dancer absolutely cannot attend the stage rehearsal scheduled for a single class/part or for multiple classes/parts please inform Mrs. Heather via email at CarrolltonAD@gmail.com. We understand that some absences cannot be avoided and will work around a dancer's absence AS LONG AS we are informed beforehand. If an email informing us of absence has not been received before a dancer's scheduled stage rehearsal we will make adjustments to choreography and/or staging so other dancers can be appropriately prepared.
- Dancers must wear normal class dress code attire for all stage rehearsals. Costumes, hair, and makeup ARE NOT REQUIRED for stage rehearsals HOWEVER, all shoes being worn during shows MUST be worn for rehearsals. Dancer's cannot accurately determine the "feel" of the stage for their performance(s) without wearing the shoes they will be performing in.
- Parents will not be permitted to watch any rehearsals. This includes all class/rehearsals on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, AND Saturday. We cannot have any parents, siblings, family members, friends, etc. in the auditorium or the blackbox theatre watching at any time during any rehearsal or it is considered a "show" per our rental contract.

PARENT MEETINGS...

To ensure that all parents feel completely prepared and ready for show weekend, we provide opportunities throughout show week where you can meet, talk, and ask questions with our desk staff, "Mama" Lisa. During parent meetings she will take you to tour the theatre, see backstage, show you where to go for sign in, etc. It is not required that you attend, but if you have additional questions after reading through show handbooks we do ask that you attend one of these meetings.

**WE RECOMMEND THAT EVERYONE READ THE SCHEDULE IN FULL!
HERE ARE SOME HELPFUL NOTES AS YOU READ:**

All Beginner, Level I, Level II, Level III, Level IV, and Level V classes are scheduled to rehearse in the black box theatre first, and will then be escorted to rehearse on stage. Each of these classes has two separate but back to back rehearsal times listed on the charts below.

All Pre-Level through Level III classes are scheduled to rehearse on the same day of the week they meet in the studio. Scheduled rehearsal times WILL DIFFER from normal class times. Level IV and Level V classes may or may not be scheduled on their normal day.

Students that were cast through auditions for additional Nutcracker roles are scheduled throughout the week.

Baby Ballet and Tiny Tap are scheduled on their normal day of the week HOWEVER, due to cast assignments, individual students may be scheduled to rehearse on a different day. Please follow the schedule for the applicable cast assignment.

APPLIES TO NUTCRACKER PARTICIPANTS ONLY...

- We will be running the entire Nutcracker show on Saturday, December 13 (referred to as Nutcracker Dress Rehearsal) in addition to the stage rehearsals mentioned above. THE NUTCRACKER DRESS REHEARSAL ON SATURDAY, DECEMBER 13 IS MANDATORY for all dancers that are scheduled. Backstage volunteers must also attend.
- Not all Nutcracker dancers are scheduled to attend the dress rehearsal. Beginner Ballet students will have their own “dress rehearsal” on Friday immediately following their pictures. Additional information can be found with the detailed schedule breakdown.
- Any routine or part of the show that has a dancer absent will be re-worked with an understudy or re-blocked/re-choreographed with only the dancers in attendance. Required hair, tights, and shoes must be worn.

PLEASE read the packets of information (show handbooks) for Nutcracker and Winter Extravaganza!

NUTCRACKER PHOTOGRAPHY DAYS: Thursday, Dec 11 & Friday, Dec 12

- All dancers must arrive 10-15 minutes prior to their scheduled picture time with hair and makeup complete with required show tights and shoes on at time of arrival. Be sure to bring required ballet shoes/pointe shoes with you. Dancers should wear warm up clothing over tights, but be sure any pants worn will not leave any fuzz on tights ;)
- Hair and makeup should follow show specific instructions found in your Nutcracker Handbook.
EXCEPTION: False lashes are not required for Beginner Ballet, Level I Ballet, and Level II Ballet for pictures (they are still required for the shows). False lashes are required for Level III, Level IV, and Level V Ballet for pictures and shows.
- Costumes will be ready for pick up upon arrival in the dressing room. A parent or guardian must be available to check out costume and assist their dancer for Beginner, Level I, Level II, and Level III students. Level IV & Level V students will dress themselves as dressing space will be limited.
- Nutcracker photography is not mandatory for non-PDC ensemble dancers.
- Please do not move, take, or touch any items backstage including but not limited to costumes and/or props unless asked to do so by CAD staff.
- Costumes must be returned to all hangers with all pieces and left in the dressing rooms as they were upon arrival.
- Due to the tight schedule, we will not be able to wait on dancers if they are late for their picture. If a dancer is late or cannot make the scheduled time for their group picture we will be happy to fit them in for an individual. In this case please understand that your individual photo will be on "standby" and you may have to wait an extended amount of time.
- Photography done by KR Photography. Information on ordering photos will be available to you during your dancers scheduled picture time. A sitting fee of \$25-\$35 required for individual photos
- Parents will not be permitted in the photography area. In most cases, extra people cause additional distractions and does not allow for the best possible picture for you and your dancer.

The only beginner level dancers that attend the Saturday Nutcracker dress rehearsal are the ones that auditioned for an extra role and have been attending Saturday rehearsals. The class ensemble (Gingerbread Children) will have an individual dress rehearsal on Friday immediately following their scheduled photos.

ADDITIONAL DRESS REHEARSAL DETAILS:

- Backstage volunteers are required to attend. This includes all dressing room and prop volunteers.
- Parents that are not volunteering to work back stage must stay in the lobby or drop off/return for pick up.
- Dancers are not permitted to be dropped off before 8:30am. EXCEPTION: Level IV and V dancers may arrive as early as 8:00am in order to warm up properly.
- All dancers must arrive with hair and makeup complete.
- All dancers must arrive dressed in leotard and tights (**ballet dress code attire**)
NOT ALL DANCERS WILL WEAR COSTUMES! PLEASE WEAR LEOTARD AND TIGHTS!
- Dancer pick up/release 11:00am.
- Dancers under the age of 14 are not permitted to stay from rehearsal until the first show time without a parent present.
